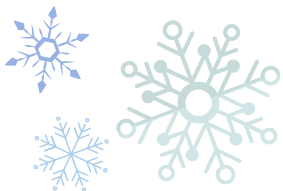

## LEGISLATIVE HOLIDAY SERVICE PROJECT

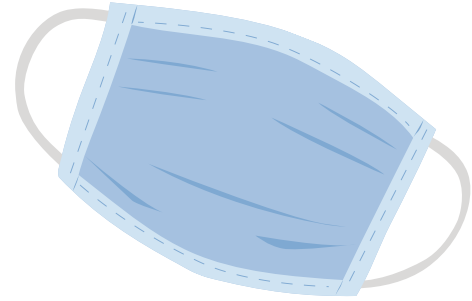
